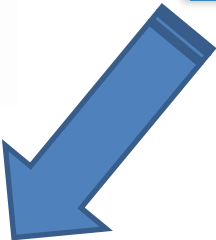
ITALIAN EDUCATION SYSTEM/ AN OVERVIEW



COMPULSORY EDUCATION
Starts at 6 years of age and lasts for 10 years



FIRST CYCLE OF EDUCATION



PRIMARY EDUCATION
Starts at 6 years of age and lasts 5 years

LOWER SECONDARY EDUCATION
Starts at 11 years of age and lasts 3 years



SECOND CYCLE OF EDUCATION
Starts at age of 14 and the first two years are compulsory

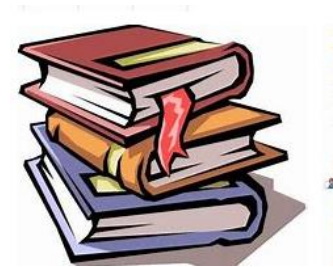


UPPER SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION
Offers both general (liceo) and vocational (technical and professional) programmes.
Courses lasts 5 years

EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL TRAINING
Offers three or four year courses with the possibility to graduate in the fourth year; it allows entering the fifth year of the upper secondary school.

FOCUS ON LEARNING

Aims



General: make students achieve a deeper understanding and acquisition of both social and linguistic skills
Specific: develop vocational competences required in the employment market

Learning approach



Emphasize workshops as focal point in the students learning path.

Features



The school is equipped with machinery and tools giving students a higher quality learning experience.

Vocational Learning

What we do:



- Partnerships with both local and international companies
- Students internships: 400 hours, split in the last three years

Why we do:



- Contextualize the theoretical knowledge applying it in different working contexts.
- Teachers fine tune their methods on working market request.

Adult Education courses (evening classes)



The school provides evening courses in “Vehicles or Industrial Goods Maintenance & Assistance” path.

Purpose:

- improve adult students' knowledge
- achieve lifelong competences
- participate in the final examination

Students target:

- Status: both workers and unemployed
- Age: in a range between 16 and 45 years
- Geographical provenience: EU and Non-EU countries (with regular VISA)

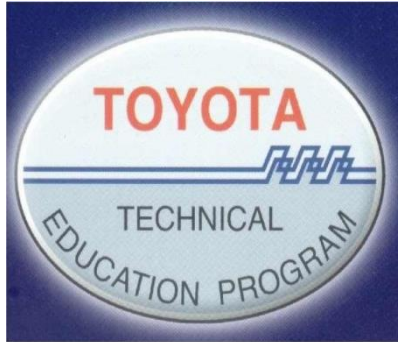
Schedule

Main School Projects (1/2)



T – TEP Toyota Project

Addressed to: students

Goal: students can benefit from high quality training besides the vocational learning hours. Also teachers can attend training courses run by Toyota.

Methodology: theoretical knowledge and vocational learning hours.



Migration & integration asylum fund

Addressed to: foreign students with some scholastic disadvantages and people without citizenship in our territory.

Goal:

- fighting against scholastic dropout
- promoting social and scholastic inclusion
- motivating individual study and cooperation between students

-Methodology:

- peer educator,
- Italian course L2 for adults and students,
- linguistic and cultural mediation.
- It involves operating a help desk during the year to allow foreign students with some scholastic disadvantages to catch some competences and contents up through the lessons in the small group and cooperative learning.



Main School Projects (2/2)



Methodology:

It involves a series of actions that promote a high quality education and a better training environment.

The project offers 3 streams of courses:

- basic knowledge
- foreign language
- physical education

Goal:

- fighting against scholastic dropout,
